

COUNSELOR CORNER

As school counselors, we want your child to be as successful as possible at school. Success in school is not just about reading and math. It is also about knowing how to learn and how to get along with others. One of the goals of the school counseling program is to help our school be a safe and respectful place where everyone can learn.

To further help our school be a safe and respectful place, we will teach a **Bullying Prevention Unit** during Phantom Skills. In this unit, your child will learn specific skills to help stop bullying.

Students will learn how to:

- Recognize when bullying is happening.
- Report bullying to a caring adult.
- **Refuse** to let bullying happen to themselves or others.
- Support someone who is being bullied by standing up for that person and being kind and inviting.

At Hemlock Creek Elementary School, we take bullying situations seriously. And we need your help! Get involved in making our school a safe and respectful place by letting us know if you hear about bullying at our school. Make sure your child knows to tell you or someone at school if he or she is being bullied, or if he or she knows about someone else being bullied. Give your child clear messages that it is never okay to bully others.

4K & KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION FOR 2024-2025



The School District of West De Pere will be holding 4K and Kindergarten registration for children who are planning to attend in the Fall of 2024 on March 7th. To be eligible for 4K enrollment, your child must turn 4 years of age on or before September 1st, 2024 and live in the West De Pere School District. To be eligible for Kindergarten, your child must turn 5 years of age on or before September 1st, 2024, and live in the West De Pere School District.
