## TORNADO AND SEVERE WEATHER AWARENESS WEEK

In Wisconsin, the week of April 8–12 is
Tornado and Severe Weather
Awareness Week. Did you
know that Wisconsin
averages 23 tornadoes
annually? Some tips to remember
are: If a tornado were to strike, move
to the lowest room or an interior room
if possible. Try to cover yourself with
blankets, towels, pillows, etc. If possible,
put yourself under a sturdy desk, counter, or
table. Always remember to stay away from
windows. A mock statewide tornado drill will
occur on April 11th.



### **COUNSELOR CORNER**

During the last week of April, Hemlock Creek students will begin the child safety unit in Phantom Skills. These lessons are designed to help students stay safe at home and at school by teaching them to 1) recognize unsafe situations, 2) refuse (say no) to participate in an unsafe situation, and 3) report anything unsafe to trusted adults.



Each lesson will help students learn three types of skills:

- Personal Safety. Students will learn important safety rules, such as safety with guns, sharp tools, and fire, and when riding on bikes or in cars. They will also learn ways to help them decide if something is safe or not.
- Touching Safety. Students will learn about safe, unsafe, and unwanted touches, and rules about touching private body parts. They will also learn to say no to unsafe or unwanted touches, and to tell an adult if someone breaks rules about touching private body parts.
- Assertiveness. These lessons will also give students a chance to practice asking an adult for help, telling an adult about an unsafe situation, and being assertive to get out of unsafe situations.



If you have questions or concerns about the Child Safety Unit, please reach out! As with all Phantom Skills units, I encourage you to talk to your child about the lessons in this child safety unit. Thank you for helping us to make our school a supportive place where everyone can learn!
