## Band Program Overview

- The schedule is that when students go to their music class, they will go to their band or choir class for 35 minutes, 3 times in a 6 day rotation
- Summer band lessons!
- Week of August 5th and August 12th
- That camp will help jumpstart learning their band instrument! Super important to make it if you are in town
- Students are committing to playing their instrument for the entire school year
- Our school district currently does not provide instruments for a majority of students. If your student is interested in band but you are worried about cost, please let me know and I'll do everything I can to make sure your student can get access to an instrument!


## Which instrument will my student play?

- Students tried their top choice instrument with me in March/April. At that time, I verified if the instrument would be a good fit and if not, we tried at least one other one.
- Students received this form. Please be sure to fill out the form!
- Still not sure which instrument is right, or student was absent on the day I was at their school?
- Please visit one of the music stores-Jim's Music or Heid Music-to have your student try instruments there.


## Expectations

Students will be expected to:

- Remember their class schedule for music
- Have all materials
- PRACTICE!
- Parents- It's OK if you don't know anything about playing an instrument. Your support and encouragement is what your new to band student needs most!

## Grading

Just like 4th grade, 5th grade will be standards based grading.
Students will be graded mostly on class participation/concert participation, practicing, and music knowledge (that we talk about in class!)

Practice logs and/or video playing assignments may be used to help me know where students are in their individual progress.

## How to get an instrument

- Rent
- Local music store options (Jim's Music, Heid Music)
- Purchase
- Please purchase a quality instrument. Best options are to go to a music store. Or if going to purchase from Facebook marketplace or something similar, ask the seller if they have proof of recent service from a music store or if you can bring it in to have it looked at by a repair technician
- Borrow/hand-me-down
- Once again, it's a really good idea to have it looked at by a certified instrumental repair technician
- Why is it important to have a quality instrument, especially if we aren't sure the student is going to stay in band or like it?
- Cheap instruments break easily and often, which results in more money on repairs, more time getting fixed which means lost playing time
- Instruments purchased on Amazon have a reputation of being poor quality...you get what you pay for!

## Recap

To make sure you are signed up for band next year, do the following:

- Instrument Verification Form needs to be completed
- Select band as your music option on another form for next year- will be sent home soon from 4th grade teachers
$\square \quad$ All 5th must choose between band or choir for next year, there is no general music option
Be sure to rent/purchase an instrument BEFORE August 5th band camp!
$\square$ Instruments that are rented will be sent to the Intermediate School to be handed out during band camp
