West De Pere Football

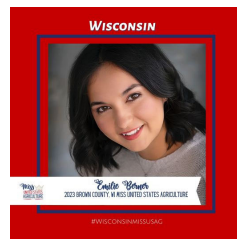
West De Pere won the 7 on 7 competition at the Packers 11-ON tournament at the Don Hutson Center.

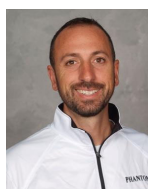
Boys High School Baseball Team
