"Super Readers":

All students who meet their grade level "super reader" goal will receive a gold star recognition shoutout.

Top 5 Readers in each Grade:

The top 5 readers from each grade will win a prize bag. The top 5 will be determined by minutes logged

Online Registration Completed:

All who complete their online registration on Fundhub will receive a special prize. Register individually or link it as a family.

Individual Prizes for Donation Goals of \$30/\$75/\$125/\$200/\$250+

There are different prizes for each amount level that is reached.



Types of Reading

reading goals can be daunting, especially for younger grades. But, there are many types of reading that count toward Every Hemlock Creek student is encouraged to actively participate in Read -a-Thon! We know that the individual individual reading goals, regardless of your student's grade level!

Any of the following reading activities can be counted toward your child's individual reading goal, as long as they happen outside of the normal school day:

- ★Read to self
- ★Reading with a partner
- ★Listening to someone read
- ★Watching someone read a book on video
- ★Reading the pictures in books
- ★Reading snap words
- ★Playing snap word memory

If you have questions about any of these reading activities, please contact your child's classroom teacher.

The individual reading goals are based on grade levels and are as follows:

Kindergarten	225 minutes	400 minutes
1st Grade	300 minutes	450 minutes
2nd Grade	350 minutes	500 minutes
3rd Grade	375 minutes	500 minutes
4th Grade	375 minutes	500 minutes
