An email from the School District of West De Pere will be sent to guardians in July to enroll your student(s) for the 2023-24 school year. Please submit ALL enrollment forms by August 7. Chromebooks are available at each school office if needed.

Census

We need your help in planning for the future in the West De Pere School District. If you have not previously filled out our Census Form, you have just moved, or you are new to the District, please contact the District Office of West De Pere or your child's school to request one.

Who needs to be counted? Household members under the age of 21 who reside at a West De Pere School District address need to be recorded on our school census even if they do not attend or plan on attending West De Pere Public Schools. If you are living in the West De Pere School District and your child(ren) attend a private school or attend school in a different district than West De Pere, they still need to be counted on the school census of the district in which they reside.

How to complete the form-

- If you have children under the age of 21 who reside at a West De Pere School District address. Be sure to include any post office box or apartment number with the actual address of the residence.
- If there are no children under the age of 21 residing at a West De Pere school district address, please complete the address section on the form, indicate there are no children under the age of 21, and return the form. We will then remove your address from our records.

FOUR-YEAR-OLD KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

The School District of West De Pere is now registering for our Four-Year-Old Kindergarten Program for children who will be four years of age on or before September 1, 2023, and are planning to attend Four-Year-Old Kindergarten in the fall of 2023. To register, please bring your child's birth certificate, immunization record, and proof of residency such as a utility bill or lease agreement to either Westwood Elementary School or Hemlock Creek Elementary School.

Our Four-Year-Old Kindergarten program is half days, five days a week. Depending on space availability at each site, children may be served at a location (either school or partnering child care facility) outside of their home school attendance area. If this occurs, transportation will be provided. Four-Year-Old Kindergarten is a voluntary program and no child will be required to attend. The 4-Year-Old Kindergarten program is developmentally appropriate and may include but is not limited to readiness skills, language development, social development, emotional development, physical development, and self-help skills.

FIVE-YEAR-OLD KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

The School District of West De Pere recently held kindergarten registration for children who are planning to attend kindergarten in the fall of 2023. In case you missed it or your child does not attend our 4K program and you are planning on sending your child to kindergarten, please register your child as soon as possible at your school of residence: Hemlock Creek Elementary School, 1900 Williams Grant Dr. De Pere or Westwood Elementary School, 1155 Westwood St. De Pere.

Children must turn five years of age on or before September 1, 2023, and live in the West De Pere School District to be eligible for the West De Pere kindergarten program. For registration, you will need to bring your child's birth certificate and proof of address. The child does not have to attend the registration. READY BODIES

Whitney Eidahl, Occupational Therapist, and Patty McCormick, Physical Therapist, have piloted a program at Westwood this year called the Ready Bodies, Learning Minds Motor Lab. The Motor Lab, created by Athena Oden, P.T., is a research based curriculum consisting of a warm up and 10 stations that target a student's sensory and motor systems including tactile, vestibular, proprioception, visual, and auditory.

The purpose of the motor lab is to improve the child's ability to function in the school environment and improve their performance in areas including handwriting, reading scores, sitting still, attention and focus, postural control, body spatial awareness, and overall behavior. The motor lab provides structured, intentional breaks for all students to utilize at Westwood in small groups or one on one with supervision from a staff member.

Most recently, the motor lab has been trialed in a whole class model with Ms. Radtke's 2nd grade class. Ms. Radtke's class came to the OT/PT room from March 7 to May 11 to complete the motor lab twice a week for 9 weeks. Some positive results seen after these 9 weeks include improved reading scores, fewer re-directions for behaviors, and overall more regulated students.





Therapy Dogs

The Middle School had a few furry friends visit them. Arlo and Boone are therapy dogs that make regular visits. They sure do bring a smile to everyone around!

The Hobart/Lawrence Police Department has a new facility/therapy dog and his handler is our very own Officer Manning, our school



liaison officer. The pup will need to attend basic obedience training, and attend and complete specific therapy dog certifications. He will be officially able to start working in the community in the spring/summer of 2024. In the


