Community Assistance Guidelines/Policies

West De Pere High School

1. All community service hours must be performed without a material or monetary reward.
2. The service hours cannot be performed directly for a family member.
(This includes parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, etc...)
3. Students cannot use court-referred hours for community service hours.
4. Activities related to campaigns for public office do not count toward service hours.
5. Direct participation in a worship service by more than just attending (i.e., usher, lector and other activities that require a sign up for) can be used to fulfill the community service requirement as well as activities that are not a direct part of the worship service such as babysitting during a worship service or parking cars at a church event, as examples.
6. Service hours will be granted for fund-raising activities for community causes, but fundraising for **WDP clubs or organizations** will not count.
7. Entertainment or performance activities that are an extension of a class or a co-curricular requirement cannot be considered for community service.

Examples of Activities that do NOT count as service hours:

West De Pere School Blood Drive - during the school day

One Act Play Competitions

Marching Band Competitions

Sport Teams – an athlete that is a member of a program that provides a service to the team such as ball boy, line judge. The athlete is doing this as a member of that sport, these are not volunteer hours.

8. Students are required to turn in their community service verification sheets **no later than two weeks after the completion of any event.**
9. Forms may be mailed in, faxed in 338-5310, or dropped off in any of the high school offices.

Verification of hours are subject to approval by the CAP committee.
