

Rehearsals will be held over two separate summer weeks and Fridays & Saturdays in fall. The production will be performed in the first weeks of January 2026. *Dare to Dream, JR*., is a musical that follows an eager group of trainees on their first day at a fictional Walt Disney Imagineering Studio. As the group sets out to help each other discover their dreams, they work together to explore the power of dreams to unite, inspire, and make anything possible.
