Technical Incentive Grant



The School District of West De Pere will CTE be receiving Career and Technical ng that works for Wisconsin Education Incentive Grant funding in the amount of \$37,976.85. This state grant

program awards funds of up to \$1000 per student to districts for the class of 2021 high school graduates who earned industry-recognized certifications. The total grant allocation was prorated across the eligible claims, resulting this year in \$843.93 per student. We had 45 eligible claims.
