## SCHOOL DISTRICT OF WEST DE PERE REGULAR BOARD MEETING WEST DE PERE HIGH SCHOOL-LIBRARY

November 17, 2021 5:30 PM

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 PM by Board President Fuss followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. President Fuss stated that the area news media had been notified of the meeting as required by open meeting law and state statutes.

The meeting was opened to the floor to enable district residents to bring items of general concern to the attention of the Board.

*Jack Mason* [1213 Lost Dauphin Rd] Stated that he doesn't agree with the mask mandate. He shared several reasons why he thinks the Board should remove the mask mandate and also that the vaccine is not safe for children.

Erin Haworth [1890 Wizard Way] Expressed how she felt she was treated at the past board meeting by other community members in attendance.

Dana Dilling [3065 Williams Grant Dr] Stressed to the Board that she wants kids to go back to normal. She thinks parents should have the choice when it comes to medical decisions for their child. *Erika Jacobs* [2193 Rolling Rd] Stated she is a nurse that works with children that are affected by COVID, and she believes that the board should vote to continue to mask the elementary students to protect all children.

It was moved by Barbara Van Deurzen and seconded by Ryan Van Den Heuvel that the October 20, 2021 annual meeting and October 20, 2021 regular meeting minutes be approved as presented. Motion carried.

It was moved by Scott Borley and seconded by Joe Bergner that the Treasurer's Report be approved. Motion carried.

Superintendent, Dennis Krueger, gave an update on the COVID status in the district. The administration made a recommendation for thresholds/transitions as it pertains to masking and quarantine.

It was moved by Ryan Van Den Heuvel and seconded by Scott Borley to return to masks optional for all students and staff. Motion failed.

It was moved by Joe Bergner to set the date to transition to masking optional on December 23, 2021. No second. Motion failed.

It was moved by Ryan Van Den Heuvel and seconded by Scott Borley to accept the recommendation regarding masking transitioning and quarantine guidelines as presented by administration. Motion carried.

It was moved by Barbara Van Deurzen and seconded by Scott Borley to approve the staffing items as presented. Motion carried.
