Booster Club Presentation ~ We were lucky to have Christian Steier from the HS Booster Club come present on what the club is all about and how parents can get involved. Here are the notes he provided:

Who We Are

The Booster Club is a non-profit organization with the purpose of supporting the student-athletes and athletic programs of West De Pere High School through funds raised running our concession stands during WDP sporting events.

What We Do

- · Offer scholarships to seniors who are pursuing a higher education, which we awarded \$15,000 to our graduation 2025 seniors.
- · Contribute \$50 per athlete per sport with money given to the coaches to use at their discretion. We gave over \$28,500 to the sports programs in the 2024-2025 school year. These funds aren't limited to sports that have concessions. This amount is given to all school organized sports teams, and the coaches can use this towards equipment, team apparel, or team meals at the discretion of our athletic director.
- · Contribute towards senior recognition, which is often used for senior banners. We gave over \$8,000 towards our seniors last year.
- · Raise money to fund items that are outside of the school budget. We recently contributed \$19,000 to reface the visitor bleachers in the indoor gymnasium.
- · Money towards banquet costs and athlete awards for each sport.

How We Do It

- Coordinate concession stands for home sporting events.
- · Volunteer at concession stands for Celebrate De Pere & Pink Flamingo.
- Parents and students volunteer for concession stand shifts. We request 2 shifts per sport your student athlete participates in per year. So, for example if your athlete is in Dance and track you would complete 4 shifts that year. You can work concessions for ANY event. Your volunteer shifts are not limited to the sport your athlete participates in. We verify that families complete their volunteer shifts for your student to be scholarship eligible.

Want To Get Involved

Normally our Booster Club meetings are held on the fourth Wednesday of each month from 6:00-7:00 pm at West De Pere High School in the multi-purpose room or cafeteria.
