<p><b><u>Physical Education</u></b></p> <p>Mrs. Lozar</p> <p>Mr. Zornow</p>	<p>Rollerblading finishes up the week before spring break with the final day for some classes on March 31 (day 6). We will start April with our Pickleball unit and continue to work on the net game skills and strategies that we started with volleyball and eclipse ball.</p> <p><b><u>Bike week: May 12-16th.</u></b> Students should bring their own bike helmets if possible. 5th grade participates in a bike rodeo with the De Pere Police Department and they will do a helmet fitting with students.</p>
<p><b><u>STEM</u></b></p> <p>Mrs. Kohl</p>	<p><b>General STEM:</b></p> <p>-We are still collecting <i>cereal boxes, paper towel cardboard inserts</i> and <i>caps to detergent bottles</i>. Feel free to send them with your child to STEM or drop them off in the office labeled "STEM."</p> <p><b>5th Grade STEM:</b> Students are working through their Robotics Unit. They will experience different types of robots and select one to race in our Robot Races. We end the year with our Measuring Time Unit.</p> <p><b>6th Grade STEM:</b> 6th grade STEM students are finishing up the Game Unit where they were given a bag of random materials which they used to create a game. 5th graders will be playing these games and providing feedback.
