One of the fun things we do on announcements each week is to share some useless information on Tuesday mornings. We call it, Totally Useless Trivia Tuesday. Students may learn about clouds, birds, trees, or even the snowiest winter in Wisconsin. Whatever it is, it is something not really useful for everyday life but is usually pretty interesting.

Well, I'd like to give you some information that is far from useless. Did you know that the state of Wisconsin has a poverty rate of 11.3%, Brown County has a poverty rate of 9.77%, and De Pere has a poverty rate of 6.6%? If you look just at our school district, 23.35% of our students come from economically disadvantaged homes. So what can we do to help our families in need this time of year? Here is one way our school has helped out.

Our student council runs a Pajama Drive to donate new pajamas for kids in need. We collected during the last couple of weeks of November and will continue for a portion of December. Our goal is to bring in at least 100 pairs of new pajamas.

Another thing happening this month is our 5th and 6th-grade choir concerts. The choir will be performing on December 12th at 6:00 for 5th grade and 7:30 for 6th grade. This concert will be held in the auditorium at the high school. We hope to see you there!

One last thing to mention is the Intermediate School Musical. This year we are performing The Grunch. We will have three performances on December 5th, 6th, and 7th. The 5th and 6th will be at 6:30 and the 7th will be at 1:30. These performances will be held at the high school auditorium as well. Tickets are on sale now, so get them while they're still available. #### **ATTENDANCE INFORMATION**

If your child will be staying home ill, needs to leave school early, or will be arriving late due to an appointment, please call the attendance line at (920) 425-1901 (selection 2). You can also email Sara Meulemans at **smeulemans@wdpsd.com** to notify the school of any absences.

If we do not hear from you about your student's absence, the office will send an email. A follow-up phone call will also be made if we do not hear back after the email. Absences are marked as "unexcused" without any notification.

If you are planning a vacation and your student will be absent for 2 or more days, please let the office and your child's teacher know via email.

Students arriving after 8:00 AM or leaving before 2:35 PM will incur a half-day absence on their attendance record.

Early release days are considered a full day for attendance. If your child is absent on an early release day, they will incur a full day absence on their attendance record.

When medical notes are provided, the absence will not count towards student truancy.

#### CITY OF DE PERE NO IDLING CLEAN AIR INITIATIVE

The No Idling Clean Air Initiative was implemented in 2023 with the support of the Unified School District of De Pere and the West De Pere School District to lower harmful gas emissions and protect the lungs of our children. This year, we are again asking drivers to turn off their engines when waiting more than 10 seconds (weather permitting) while picking up children.

We would love you to commit to No Idling; the positive effects are great for our schools, students, community, and environment! Not idling is a great way to make sure the air in your children's classroom is clean and it helps the schools out, too! Not idling means that children with asthma and allergies will not get sick because fumes from idling affect their health. I in 13 school-age children have asthma. Not idling means that greenhouse gas emissions will be lower and that is good for the challenges of climate change. We ask for your support; it is an easy way to provide clean air for everyone! #### **VOLUNTEERS**

For safety reasons, anyone requesting to volunteer within the school must complete a Background Check Application two weeks prior to the event and be approved prior to volunteering, unless previously approved. We keep disruptions to a minimum to ensure that students are able to focus on academic learning time.


#### LIBRARY NEWS

#### FRENCH CLUB


